This seminar is for both clergy and laity, and I look forward to every church in the district being represented. **Please respond to the district office by noon on July 23** with the number from your church who will be attending. **There is a signup sheet at the "information center" in you plan to go!**

Typically called a "Paragraph 213 Study" you will learn how this process includes the methods for you to discover: unique missional opportunities and needs of your community, growth potential of the surrounding community, and how to address a number of items that impact your ability to grow and thrive. Our Book of Discipline encourages every congregation to take stock of their present reality and future potential on a regular basis, and this process, which Amy will present and explain, enables churches to do just that. As you are considering decisions and visions that will move your congregation into 2019 (and beyond), this assessment will be invaluable for your church to be poised to be making disciples and fulfilling God's plan for your church.
